ORAL COMMENTS

<u>Plant Lift Station Wastewater Screening Unit</u> A manufacturer representative was onsite for startup. There was an issue with the level sensor that needs to be corrected. Consideration of Substantial Completion (pending replacement of the level sensor). Anticipated Construction Schedule is Screening unit startup April 11-12 and Final Completion mid to late April. <u>Miscellaneous Services:</u> GIS has been updated with the available elevation information to all sanitary sewer manholes. Recent projects are being added to the system as well. Information is being collected for the potential AC waterline replacement project.

OPERATORS' REPORT

L. Strohschein gave the operators' report for the month citing the following specifics:

Water/Sewer samples tested good for the month: Installed a rubber gasket for RJ-3 well head; Nitrite/Nitrate samples were delivered to Gillette for test results to be sent to EPA; A well head vent for RJ-5 has been ordered; Consumer Confidence Report was completed and will be sending to EPA; and RJ-8 well heads were barricaded Survey request. Materials for the vent on the new tank have been ordered and should be completed by the end of the month; Vac truck cleaned the overflow drain pan at the new tank: This month was a 5-sample month for the sewer: Generator at RJ-7 was exercised; Power was reset due to the plant level control faulted causing communication problems; Built a trash can receptacle for the Plant Lift Station Screening Unit. The Unit was started only to find the level control sensor was bad and startup was delayed due to waiting on new part; Installed one new water and sewer tap and one new meter curb box and rod; Turned water on at three locations; One meter wire replaced; New temperature sensor installed in de-chlorination building; Installed one new register; 13 doorknockers and multiple locates.
